



NATIONAL ELITE (Senior) TEAM 2023 SELECTION CRITERIA

This document outlines the criteria by which the 2023 (April 1, 2023 – March 31, 2024) Wake Canada National **Elite Team** shall be selected. The Wake Canada National Team Committee (WCNTC) shall have the authority to make all decisions with respect to the criteria.

Process Timeframe

Deadline for Submission – February 15, 2023

The following documents must be submitted by email to wakecanada@wswc.ca by February 15, 2023:

- Completed Wake Canada **ELITE** Team Application / Declaration of Intent (Form 1) required
- Extenuating Circumstances Submission, if applicable

Team Selection

- Team selection will be made as soon as possible following processing of application submissions.

National ELITE Team

Introduction

Wake Canada's wake program goal is to support our country's top riders as they strive to achieve success at the highest level of competition in Wakeboard Boat; Wake Park Cable, Wakesurf and Wakeskate.

The Wake Canada National Team program consists of two teams:

- (1) National ELITE Team members (see separate selection criteria for national Development team)
- (2) National DEVELOPMENT Team members (up to age 21)

Athletes are only eligible to be selected to one team, "ELITE" or "DEVELOPMENT", within the National Team program.

ELITE Teams' Goal

To achieve the highest level of international success in the Pro/Open categories of world titled events and highest level international championships. (Emphasis is on world championships).

Prerequisites for Eligibility

To be eligible for consideration to the Canadian Wake National **ELITE Team**, the athlete must be:

- A member in good standing with their provincial wake sports provincial sport organization or Wake Canada / WSWC
- Are deemed eligible by the WWA (World Wake Sports Association) and/or IWWF (International Water Ski and Wakeboard Federation) and/or CWSA (Competitive Wakesurf Association), as case may be
- Hold a valid Canadian passport

Selection Term

Subject to the athlete signing a Team Athlete Agreement, the term of team selection shall be for one year, from April 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024.

Selection Criteria

Selection to the 2023 Wake National **ELITE Team** will be determined on demonstration of individual competition performances, training commitment and international competition plans. A significant factor will be the results at the 2022 Wake Canada National Championship*: Wakeboard Boat; Wake Park Cable; and Wakesurf.

**If an athlete could not attend a National Championship in their respective discipline because they are participating on the same day at an event of higher ranked status they should submit a letter to the WCNTC for consideration.*

Selection Process

The following criteria shall be considered for 2023 Wake Canada National **ELITE Team** selection purposes:

- Results from a 2022 Wake Canada National Championship as outlined above
- Results from a 2022 World Championship or similar highest level International pro championships
 - Results from a another International pro championship
- Level of **commitment to training, competing and potential**, as determined by the WCNTC, through the review of the Wake Canada National Team Application (Form 1)
- Qualities of fair-play

Only results from the pro / open divisions (including Junior Pro Men) will be taken into account for the selection process. The events to be considered must be in the same wake discipline.

Should a rider so qualified decline the National **ELITE Team** selection invitation, vacant spots will be filled by the next highest ranked qualifying rider at the sole discretion of the WCNTC, which may or may not take into account results used in the above criteria.

Competition Readiness

The WCNTC may, at any time, at their discretion, disqualify an athlete from being considered for selection to the National Team or remove an athlete after selection if, due to illness, injury, lack of commitment to compete and/or train, or other reason which affects the athlete's ability to perform, or if the WCNTC believes it unlikely that the athlete will be able to perform at a level consistent with the scores upon which the selection of the athlete to the Team would be or was based. The WCNTC will advise the affected athlete of his decision. Such a decision may be appealed in accordance with WSWC's Appeal Policy.

Extenuating Circumstances

If extenuating circumstances prevent an athlete from competing in selection events (outlined above) or adversely affect the athlete's performances, the WCNTC may make exceptions to the selection criteria. If an athlete wants the WCNTC to consider making exceptions to the selection criteria, the athlete must make a written submission to the WCNTC. The written submission must be submitted by email wakecanada@wswc.ca by February 15, 2023. Following receipt of the submission, the WCNTC may require additional written information from the athlete. The WCNTC's decision will be communicated to athletes who may be affected by the decision.

Appeals

An athlete may appeal any decision made pursuant to this document. An appeal shall be made and dealt with in accordance with the most recent version of WSWC's Appeals Policy. A copy of the Appeals Policy is available from WCNTC / WSWC upon request and is posted on the WSWC's website at www.wswc.ca.

Application - Declaration of Intent to Qualify for National ELITE Team

In order to be considered for Wake Canada National **ELITE** Team selection please complete and sign the “**ELITE Team Application – Declaration of Intent**” on the WakeCanada.ca website and submit via email to: wakecanada@wswc.ca by **February 15, 2023**.

Submission of an Application and meeting Prerequisites for Eligibility does not necessarily earn Team selection. Selection is subject to process outlined above and discretion of WCNTC. The number of **ELITE** Team spots is at the discretion of the WCNTC.
